It is the toughest day on the Central route in this itinerary because of two steep and long ascents and descents. Make sure to carry enough water and some snacks. If you find it too challenging you can split the day and stop in Rubiaes.

- A steep and long ascent at the start of the day, 300 m up
- A subsequent steep and long descent, 250 m down
- Another steep ascent at 10 km/6.2 mi, 100 m up
- A steep and long descent at the end of the day, 200 m down
