Stage 1. Se Cathedral, Porto to Matosinhos, 10.5 km/6.5 mi

- Distance – 10.5 km/6.5 mi
- Time – 3 hours (moving time)
- Ascent – 60 m
- Descent – 90 m
- Walking surface – 9.5 km/5.5 mi – tar road; 1 km/0.6 mi - boardwalk.
- Walking along the coast – 10 km/6.2 mi, along the Douro River and the coast.

Highlights

- Se Cathedral and the historical center of Porto.
- Walking along the Douro River.
- Beautiful beaches and seaside.

Challenges

- The first 10 km from the Cathedral are not marked. It's not difficult to find the route; you follow the Douro River for 10 km till you get to the information office in Matosinhos. From there you can follow the yellow arrows.

Stage 12. São Pedro da Torre to Tui (Spain), 9 km/5.6 mi

It's a short walking day which gives you enough time to explore the beautiful fortress in Valença and another fortress in Tui on the opposite side of the river.

- Distance – 9 km/5.5 mi
- Time – 2 hours (moving time)
- Ascent – 140 m
- Descent – 110 m
- Walking surface – 5 km/3.1 mi – tar road; 2 km/1.2 mi - cobbled; 2 km/1.2 mi – footpath/gravel road.

Highlights

- The historical center of Valença.
- The impressive Valença Fortress. Make sure you spend some time exploring it.
- Walking across the metal bridge over the Minho River which forms a natural border between Portugal and Spain. The views from the bridge are spectacular.
- The historical center and fortress of Tui.

Challenges

- A change of time once you cross the bridge from Portugal to Spain. Spain is 1 hour ahead of Portugal.
